Predominant trees of the Yucatan Peninsula



Balché

Tree with dense, rounded foliage, showy flowers lilac-purple; the fruits are flat pods. Endemic to the Yucatan Peninsula.



Caoba

Tree with a straight trunk presenting shapely buttresses, the cup is lush, open like a fan; small yellowish green flowers; the fruits are woody capsules, ovoid, reddish-brown color.



Cedro

Tree with a straight trunk; The cup is lush and rounded; the flowers are small and fragrant cream; the fruits are dark brown capsules. Deciduous species that blooms from May to August.



Ceiba

Gigantic deciduous tree, large round or flat top, palmate compound leaves, solid cylindrical trunk, thick and straight, with large buttresses, actinomorphic flowers scented whitish to pink petals.



Chaká

Tree with straight, scaly and very branched stem cup; the flowers are very fragrant small cream-green; drupaceous fruits are capsules. It is a deciduous species.



Chiit

Palma straight trunk and thin fan-shaped leaves; flowers occur in short, lots of small cream-colored flowers inflorescences; The fruit is spherical.



Despeinada

Bush with markedly thickened stem at the base and in stark contrast to the upper branches; the flowers are small cream-colored, arranged in long highly branched inflorescences; the fruits are trigonas and winged capsules.



Guarumo

Conifer, mirmecófilo; umbrella-shaped crown, stratified; leaves spiral, simple, peltate, dark green; monopódico trunk, cylindrical, straight, hollow in the center; smooth bark, light gray.



Jabín

Semi-deciduous tree, irregular glass, wood cream-yellow color, compound leaves imparipinnate, showy yellow flowers in clusters, fruits are flattened pods of yellowish-brown with several greenish yellow seeds.



Kitanché

Semi-deciduous tree, irregular glass, wood cream-yellow color, compound leaves imparipinnate, showy yellow flowers in clusters, fruits are flattened pods of yellowish-brown with several greenish yellow seeds.



Kuka

Palma straight trunk without branches grayish brown; It has large pinnate, leathery leaves, clustered at the trunk; the flowers are small cream; the fruits are small drupes globose, dark brown.



Makulis amarillo

Straight and cracked tree trunk and pyramidal crown; flowers are yellow, very showy, arranged at the end of the branches; the fruits are slightly twisted capsules.



Makulis rosa

Straight and cracked tree trunk and pyramidal crown; the flowers are pink-purple color, very showy, arranged at the end of the branches; the fruits are slightly twisted capsules.



Mangle rojo

Right tree trunk with abundant stilt roots, rounded crown; flowers greenish-yellow; the fruits contain a single seed that produces a radicle that emerges to be embedded in the muddy ground.



Pich

Large deciduous tree, abundant foliage, leaves bipinnate, ascending branches, light gray bark with abundant elongated lenticels; actinomorphic stemmed flowers in small heads, tubular calyx green and light green corolla.



Ramón

Evergreen tree, dense pyramidal crown, simple leaves, unisexual flowers, fruit orange or red when ripe, seeds spherical and flat covered with a papery seed coat light brown color.



Roble

Evergreen shrub or tree, dense rounded crown, lanulose leaves, terminal inflorescence with many white flowers, fruits subglobose small yellow and then red or purple when ripe.



Siricote

Deciduous tree, very dense rounded crown, very rough simple leaves, flowers in panicles with intensely orange corolla, fruits as yellow when ripe drupe.



Tecoma

Small tree with a straight trunk and rounded crown; flowers appear in clusters of yellow, arranged at the end of the branches; the fruits are pods.



Zapote

Conifer, simple leaves, flowers solitary white corolla, fruit shell as brown and rough berries, juicy and very sweet fleshy endocarp, seeds black and bright color.
